Outing Results for 2018

Numbers were slightly down on previous years with 33 people playing at Muirfield and only 3 at Gifford. Muirfield was again a stiff test with the Morrison Quaich being won by David Rudd with a scratch score of 76. The Linton medal for the best net score was won byKenny Milne with a stableford score of 34 points. The Middleton Trophy was won by Graheme Clarke with 38 points. Both competitions were followed by a most enjoyable buffet meal in the Old Clubhouse in Gullane.

The Autumn Meeting returned to Muckhart with 18 members in attendance. The Tawse Medal for the best scratch score was won by Dave Campbell with a score of 73 while the Centenary Trophy was won by John Richardsoin with 39 stableford points.
