

George Heriot's School FP Golf Club SUMMER COMPETITION RULES



The following rules apply to the Summer Singles, Summer Foursomes, Club Championship and "B" Championship:

- The first named in each tie is the Challenger
- The Challenger has the choice of venue
- The Challenger is responsible in the first instance for arranging the tie
- The Challenger must contact his Opponent at the earliest and offer a minimum choice of three dates
- One of the dates offered must be at a weekend and not more than two dates may be in the same week
- If the Opponent is unable to play on any of the dates offered the Challenger may claim the tie
- If the Challenger fails to offer the Opponent dates as detailed above, the Opponent may claim the tie

NB THE INTENTION IS TO HAVE TIES PLAYED WHEREVER POSSIBLE AND NOT TO HAVE WALKOVERS PLEASE DO GET ON THE PHONE WHEN YOU RECEIVE THIS DRAW — DO NOT LEAVE IT UNTIL THE LAST WEEK AND, OF COURSE, THERE IS NO REASON WHY THE OPPONENT MAY NOT MAKE FIRST CONTACT

Handicap Rules:

- SINGLES Full Handicap difference is given.
- FOURSOMES Half the combined Handicap difference is given.
- CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP Played off scratch.
- 'B' CHAMPIONSHIP Played off scratch. The final of the "A" Championship is played over 36 holes home and away. The Finals of all the other competitions are played over one round, with the player (s) at the top of the draw having choice of venue.

Extensions:

Extensions to the dates may be allowed under certain circumstances, but only if applied for "in good time" and with an actual date agreed. Extensions, if required, should be sought from Grahame Clarke
